Dr. Susan B. Stearns, Associate Professor of Cell and Developmental Biology, received her PhD in Anatomy from Upstate in 1976. After a two year post doctoral fellowship in the Department of Pharmacology, she accepted a faculty appointment in the Department of Anatomy. Her research interests included various parameters of glucose and glycogen metabolism that characterize diabetes and the endocrinology of breast tumors maintained in organ culture. Presently she is the director of the Human Anatomy Course and of the Summer Gross Anatomy Program and is a facilitator in the Ethical, Legal and Social Issues of Medicine component of the Practice of Medicine course. In addition, as Assistant Dean of Student Affairs, she is in charge of the Center for Civic Engagement. Dr. Stearns is a Senior Advisory Dean, a member of the Admissions Committee for the College of Medicine and for the Physician's Assistant Program and a member of the Advisory Board of the Amaus Health Services and of Southwest Community Center.
