WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Medical students from the Class of 2022 or 2023 at Upstate Medical University are eligible. The student must hold similar ideals to Dr. Sarah Loguen Fraser. The award is principally based on need, but the recipient must also have a genuine desire to provide service to the medically under-served. Strong candidates for this award should also have demonstrated leadership qualities and a willingness to give of themselves through volunteer work or other efforts that make a positive impact on the lives of others.

SARAH LOGUEN FRASER, MD, CLASS OF 1876

Sarah Loguen Fraser, MD graduated in 1876 from what was then Syracuse University College of Medicine. In 1950, the college became part of the SUNY system and is now part of Upstate Medical University.

Born in Syracuse, NY in 1850, Dr. Loguen Fraser was the daughter of former slave and leading abolitionist, Reverend Jermain Wesley Loguen, bishop of the AME Zion Church. One of the first women to graduate from the medical college and the first African-American woman to do so, the Syracuse newspapers acknowledged at the time of her 1873 enrollment, "This is 'woman's rights' in the right direction.

After graduation, Dr. Loguen Fraser interned in Philadelphia and Boston and practiced medicine in Washington, D.C., and Santo Domingo (now the Dominican Republic). From 1882 until his death in 1894, she was married to pharmacist and land-owner Charles Fraser, whom she met through Frederick Douglass. The Frasers had a daughter named Gregoria Alejandrina. Mother and daughter lived in Syracuse from 1901 until 1907, when they moved to Washington, D.C., where Dr. Loguen Fraser lived until her death in 1933.
